The course is also suitable for postgraduate musicians who are already working professionally.

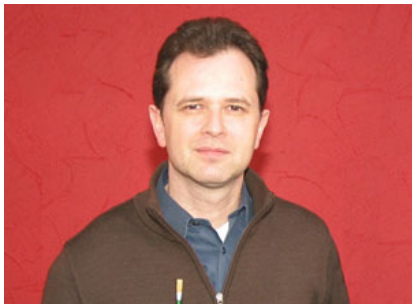
The Woodwind Festival aims to be a platform for encounter and exchange on the highest level between musicians from all countries.
